

Pecan Fundraiser Instructions

Dear Players and Parents:

In order to support our basketball program and hold down the fees paid directly by parents we must have successful fundraiser(s) such as this pecan effort. Following the below directions will greatly facilitate this fundraiser.

General Information

1. A family may choose to opt out of the fundraiser (not sell any pecans); the buyout cost is \$150.
2. Order forms will be distributed to players at Picture Day (Sunday, November 11) and must be returned to their head coach at practice on Thursday, November 29th. Please total all orders and recount corresponding funds before submitting them in the envelope provided.
3. Each player must sell 40 items of product at \$8 each. Collect payment when the order is placed. All checks (related to product orders or buyouts) should be made out to the Parkview Tip-Off Club. If the 40 item minimum is not met, you will need to pay \$5/item short to cover the lost profit (please write "shortage fee" notation line of this check).
4. Pick-up day of the pecans is Saturday, December 8th from 10:00 AM – noon at Parkview. The player must pick up the entire order at this time (no customer pick-ups). The player should then deliver the product within 5 days, as many customers will use it over the holiday period.

Selling Tips

1. Wear Parkview Basketball clothing and introduce yourself by name as a Parkview basketball team member selling holiday season pecans as a fundraiser for the basketball program. Take two copies of the order form (one so the customer can look at the pictures of the products while you write on the other one) and a something to write on (clipboard).
2. Try to sell multiple units per customer- these are great inexpensive holiday gifts (e.g.- gifts to teachers, business associates, customers or relatives).
3. No holiday shopping traffic and beats on-line ordering with no shipping charges.
4. Great Holiday baking item.
5. Excellent quality and value- This is this year's Georgia pecan crop- fresher than what's normally purchased in the grocery store and comparably priced. Satisfaction is guaranteed (may return the product to receive refund or replacement product).
6. Smile . . . and do not procrastinate!
